With its associations of Italian style and Ia bella vita, the Negroni has always had a blush of romanticism about it.

## OLD FASHIONED

#### Four Roses Small Batch Bourbon, Demerara Sugar, Angostura and Orange Bitters, Orange

When you get right down to it, the Bourbon Old Fashioned is little more than a slug of whiskey, seasoned and sweetened. Yet for all its suave simplicity, the drink remains as relevant today as it was when it first captured drinkers' hearts 200 years ago.

#### VESPER MARTINI

The Espresso Martini is made with vodka, but this version is more like a slightly boozy espresso shot. In it, espresso is enhanced with an amaro and Kahlúa, creating a rich, botanical, and dark drink with as much caffeine as it has alcohol, if not more.

Made with essences from Valencia oranges grown in Brazil and Florida, as well as Mandarin oranges from Italy.

JJ WHITLEY ARTISANAL VODKA, England, £3.00

An artisanal vodka made in Lancashire from high-quality winter wheat and naturally soft water from local wells. Soft and creamy.

STOLICHNAYA VANILLA VODKA, Latvia, £3.00

Stolichnaya Vanilla has elegant aromas of vanilla pod, creme anglaise, and chocolate, with undertones of toasted buttery grain.

## AGAVE

CAZCABEL COFFEE, Mexico (Served Chilled), £4.75

With the fresh and earthy blanco tequila at the heart, Cazcabel Coffee blends a roasted sweet hit of luxury coffee to the spirit. The liquid is simply stunning. Perfectly balanced, silky smooth, dry and not too sweet. Hints of chocolate, vanilla and agave. Dare we say that it's better than Café Patron!

CAZCABEL HONEY, *Mexico, (Served Chilled), £4.75* The honey is taken from the sacred bees, blessed by Don Cazcabel himself. The taste is rich, sweet and full of honey.

#### CAZCABEL BLANCO, Mexico, £4.85

The spirit is fresh, crisp and a beautiful balance of the agave's earthy notes with fresh citrus that emerges during the distillation process.

QUIQUIRIQUI ESPADIN MEZCAL, Mexico, £8.50

It has a smooth taste with distinct roasted agave flavours and a peppery finish that is a characteristic of the Espadin agave.

# RUM

#### 25ml

RON ABUELO 15 YEAR OLD TAWNY PORT FINISH, Panama, £7.25 Finished in tawny-port casks, this expression in Abuelo's XV Finish Collection has notes of berries and excellent balance between sweetness and dried-fruit flavours.

#### DON PAPA, Philippines, £5.15

Don Papa Rum is inspired by Papa Isio, one of the unsung heroes of the Philippine Revolution. Once a foreman at a sugar plantation before joining the independence movement, Papa Isio drove out the conquerors of his beloved land. Distilled from some of the finest sugar cane in the world on the island of Negros in the Philippines, Don Papa is first aged 7 years in oak barrels in the foothills of Mount Kanlaon before being blended to perfection.

#### FOURSQUARE SPICED, Bajan, £3.75

What really impresses is the balance and level of spicing on show. Some spiced rums crank up the vanilla sweetness too much, but this is just right, with the spices allowed to shine.

#### ALUNA COCONUT, Guatemala, £3.00

Clean, authentic notes of coconut arrive first, with hints of tropical fruits in the background.

#### EL DORADO 15 YEAR OLD, Guyana, £6.75

A four-time winner of World's Best Rum at the International Wine & Spirits Challenge, it's as rich and sweet as they come, a complex fusion of fruit and spice. Perfect for long sipping, straight or on the rocks. A Classic!

# HAVANA CLUB AÑEJO 3 YEAS OLD, *Cuba, £3.00*

Havanan Club 3 is full of Cuban passion, atmosphere & optimism. With accents of vanilla & caramelised pear on the nose and smoky, chocolate, vanilla notes on the palate.

#### HAVANA CLUB AÑEJO 7 YEAS OLD, *Cuba, £3.50* Sweet Cuban tobacco, lush tropical fruits, notes of honey and rich brown spices with dry cocoa.

#### GIN

#### 25ml

#### JAFFA CAKE, England, £5.00

Consider the Jaffa cake. A timeless treat. Now, if something is delicious, chances are someone will make a gin with it, and that's exactly what has happened here. Jaffa Cake Gin is distilled with oranges, fresh orange peel, cocoa powder and Jaffa cakes. Actual Jaffa cakes. The result is just like you'd expect - full-on Jaffa cake tastiness built around a distinctive base of crisp juniper.

#### GIN MARE, Spain, £5.00

A lovely London Gin which is made with botanicals including basil, kaffir lime leaves and lavender, and it's distilled in copper pot stills.

#### MONKEY 47, Germany, £6.50

Hits of fresh citrus and ripe juniper on the nose, followed by a vegetal and slightly wooded finish that's extremely complex and robust.

#### SIPSMITH, England, £3.60

Dry Juniper leads, then reveals Lemon tart and Orange Marmalade, before all the flavours harmonise.

#### TANQUERAY NO. 10, Scotland, £3.75

Tanqueray No. Ten it set itself apart by not just using fruit peel, but fresh grapefruit, orange, lime and camomile are used to flavour.

#### WHITLEY NEILL, England, £3.00

An African-inspired gin made with baobab fruit and Cape gooseberry to give it a more exotic feel than other gins.

#### SACRED PINK GRAPEFRUIT, England, £4.75

From the Sacred craft distillery in Highgate comes the Pink Grapefruit Gin, made using every bit of the grapefruit, from the flesh to the peel to even the pips! It may sound obvious, but by golly does this have some phenomenal pink grapefruit flavours. KI NO BI, Japan, £5.25

Floral and aromatic with refreshing yuzu standing out. Subtly earthy, oak-y elements develop, joined by a kick of ginger.

#### PORTOBELLO ROAD NO. 171, England, £3.50

This gin was released by the award-winning Notting Hill bar, Portobello Star. This is a place where one can learn an awful lot about gin, so you would expect Portobello Road No. 171 to be rather good, and indeed it is. It's an old-style London Dry Gin, containing traditional botanicals and spices, that harks back to the gins of yesteryear.

#### AMÁZZONI DRY, Brazil, £6.00

Amázzoni Gin is produced over in the Cachoeira Farm, said to be the first dedicated gin distillery in Brazil! Five Amazonian botanicals, cocoa, Brazilian chestnut, maxixe, water lily and cipò cravo, shine alongside six more traditional gin botanicals. The botanicals are macerated in a Brazilian-made pot still before it's blended with Amazonian water and bottled up.

#### NEVER NEVER TRIPLE JUNIPER, Australia, £6.50

The Never Never Distilling Co. in Australia like juniper. A lot. In fact, for its Triple Juniper Gin, the adored seed cone imparts is flavours to the spirit in three ways...

#### AN DÚLAMÁN IRISH MARITIME, Ireland, £4.60

All the way from Ireland's County Donegal comes An Dúlamán Irish Maritime Gin, which wears its coastal influence on its sleeve. The botanical selection for this tipple includes five different varieties of locally-harvested seaweed, alongside six other specially selected botanicals.

#### RHUBARB & RASPBERRY, England, £4.15

Tarquin's Rhubarb and Raspberry Gin starts with, tart red berry backed up with floral juniper, angelica and violet. A good helping of cinnamon brings a spicy kick to the mid palate, giving balance of rhubarb and raspberry.

#### MERMAID ZEST GIN, England, £4.60

A zesty, aromatic infusion of Mermaid Gin with summer citrus fruits and wild foraged, coastal botanicals. Grapefruit and cascade hops are blended with island bergamot, lemon zest and rosemary, 'the dew of the sea', then distilled and infused with our signature gin. The result is a zesty, fresh spirit with a hint of sea air.

#### PLYMOUTH, England, £3.10

Plymouth Gin has great depth of flavour with deep earthy notes and a wonderfully fresh juniper and lemony bite.

#### HENDRICKS, Scotland, £4.00

Hendrick's wondrous botanical signature consists of flowers, roots, fruits and seeds from the world over.

#### MALFY ROSA, Italy, £3.50

Made from 5 botanicals, Italian juniper, Sicilian pink grapefruit and Italian rhubarb. Quality gin that is bursting with flavour.

#### HAPUSA HIMALAYAN DRY, India, £4.60

Out of all the international Gins, this one sets the bar. An incredible smooth Gin produced from Juniper and botanicals sourced from the pine forests located at the foot of the Himalayans.

#### CITADELLE, France, £3.75

On the nose, hints of violet, sweet orange, coriander and floral brightness. The taste begins quietly until the aromatics re-enter the nose and the finish is what sets Citadelle apart from its peers: really bright, a touch sweet and fennel on the finish.

#### PANAREA ISLAND GIN, Italy, £4.70

An refreshingly herbaceous gin made using a combination of juniper, myrtle berries, citrus peels, coriander and more. The name comes from one of the small Aeolian Islands off the coast of Sicily.

#### DANCING SANDS SAUVIGNON BLANC GIN, *New Zealand, £4.50* If you're one of those people who struggles to choose between an icy, refreshing G&T, and a large glass of chilled Sauvignon, then this marvellous creation will solve that issue! This gin is produced by vacuum distilling New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc wine, along with a host of botanicals, including manuka leaves, almonds, cardamom, and liquorice.

#### HERNÖ GIN, Sweden, £6.75

Herno Gin is crafted from natural and carefully selected organic botanicals, made in the Herno Gin Distillery, the first dedicated gin distillery in Sweden. On the nose, Herno Gin has a fresh citrus aroma with a floral complexity whereas on the palate, it has a combination of sweet and spicy notes.

# COGNAC, ARMAGNAC AND CALVADOS

BAS-ARMAGNAC 1984 CASTARÈDE, ARMAGNAC, *France, £6.80* This 1984 Bas Armagnac from highly regarded Casterède is a blend of 50% Ugni Blanc, 30% Colombard and 20% Folle Blanche. This combines notes of fruity peach and prune with pepper, vanilla, and a hint of nuttiness.

#### MAISON SASSY, CALVADOS, France, £4.15

This is a rich gold, apple-scented Calvados from a family estate that's been working with their apples since 1852. All their orchards today are organic. Barrel aged for over two years, this eau de vie is vibrant.

#### CASTARÈDE VS BAS, ARMAGNAC, France, £4.75

Fruity and pleasant nose with light pepper, coconut and honeyed dried fruit. The oak is structured and to taste the Armagnac is balanced and filled with dried fruit, coconut-like dried fruits, oak and a long walnut like finish.

#### HENNESSY VS, COGNAC, France, £4.25

The "V.S" stands for "Very Special", and this cognac lives up to its name. It is made from a blend of over 40 different eaux-de-vie. This results in a smooth, full-bodied cognac with notes of vanilla, spice, and dried fruit.

HINE ANTIQUE XO PREMIER CRU, COGNAC, *France, £14.00* Hine Antique XO Premier Cru Cognac is created using grapes from the Grande Champagne region and is a blend of 40 different cognacs, aged for over 10 years. This is a light cognac with spicy and peppery notes with an elegantly long finish.

BISQUIT & DUBOUCHE VSOP, COGNAC, *France, £7.65* An excellent cognac to drink neat. To enjoy it to the fullest, sip the liquid and savour its sweetness, rich aroma and age. Taking small sips allows the cognac to expand in the mouth, delivering an intense and aromatic experience.

METAXA 12 YEARS OLD, BRANDY, *Greece, £4.75* Metaxa 12 Stars is a smooth, premium Greek brandy that is perfect for sipping on its own or enjoying with friends. It has a rich, complex flavour that makes it perfect for after-dinner drinks or enjoyed neat.

## WHISKY, WHISKEY, BLENDED AND BOURBON

# CAMPBELTOWN

#### GLEN SCOTIA DOUBLE CASK, 46%, £3.75

Glen Scotia Double Cask Whisky is matured in the finest first-fill bourbon barrels before being finished for nine to twelve months in Pedro Ximenez sherry casks producing this outstanding single malt whisky that provides the perfect balance of rich spicy fruits, overlaid with the characteristic sea spray and vanilla oak finish for which Glen Scotia is famous.

#### KILKERRAN 12 YEAR OLD, 46%, £4.50

The long-awaited first core product from Kilkerran – a 12-year-old. This lightly peated whisky has been aged in combination of 70% bourbon casks and 30% sherry casks. The distillery was reopened in 2004 after being closed for almost 80 years, and this bottling has been eagerly anticipated ever since.

# SPEYSIDE

#### GLENFARCLAS 10 YEAR OLD, 46%, £3.40

Glenfarclas 10 Year Old Single Malt is a sherried whisky which has well balanced richness - it gives depth to its malty characteristics, whilst showcasing its delightfully sweet and soft notes.

#### CRAIGELLACHIE 13 YEAR OLD, 46%, £5.15

A range of Craigellachie single malts was released for the first time in 2014. The distillery is known for its meaty character, and the 13-year-old is sweet, spicy and slightly smoky.

DAILUAINE 6 YEAR OLD, TBWC, BATCH 6, *57.9%, £4.15* Delectable Dailuaine, bottled up by Boutique-y Company for its Boutique-y Records release! This one was given 6 years of maturation in a sherry hogshead before being bottled up at 57.9% ABV. The label features a design that looks like a old soul 7" record, with the pun "Soul for Us" hinting at Dailuaine's flavour profile. Clever, very clever... Batch 6 is a release of 374 bottles.

# HIGHLAND

#### DEANSTON VIRGIN OAK, 46.3%, £4.50

Deanston Virgin Oak is made with young whisky which has been finished in brand new oak casks from Kentucky. Always a pleasure to have Deanston single malt Scotch whisky around, as they are certified by the Organic Food Association and power their distillery using hydro energy, so you can always feel good about the delicious dram in your hand.

#### GLENCADAM 10 YEAR OLD, 46%, £3.50

Released for the first time in 2008, Glencadam was bottled and released under the new Angus Dundee ownership and is well-balanced, distinct and full of tart fruit flavour. It is malty yet sweet and is a real delight to drink.

#### ARDNAMURCHAN AD, 46.8%, £4.15

More awesomeness here from Ardnamurchan! You might be wondering what happened with the name on this one, did the folks at Ardnamurchan forget to add all the usual numbers to the end? The answer is simple, this is no mistake! Going forward, Ardnamurchan's AD/ bottlings will no longer have all those confusing digits. The whisky remains unchanged though, following its traditional combination of 50% peated and 50% unpeated malt, matured in a combination of 65% bourbon and 35% sherry casks.

# ISLAY

#### BUNNAHABHAIN 10 YEARS OLD, 46%, £4.50

This indie Bunnahabhain was bottled up courtesy of Gordon & MacPhail. The Islay whisky was aged for a decade and bottled for the Discovery series at 43% ABV. The bottling series is colour coded, so this we can tell from this expression that it's got a 'smoky' flavour profile, which is unusual for a Bunnahabhain!

#### CAOL ILA 12 YEAR OLD, 43%, £4.30

Caol IIa 12 Year Old is of medium weight, but still packing plenty of potent phenols, this is a refined, powerful dram with a compensating oiliness. A balanced, peaty beauty...

# **ISLAND**

#### TOBERMORY 12 YEARS OLD, 46%, £4.75

The picturesque harbour town of Tobermory is probably best known these days for its colourful houses and association with children's television, but as it turns out they know a thing or two about whisky as well. This 12 year old expression is irrefutable proof, a salty character with a sweet floral finish.

# LOWLAND

#### LOCHLEA OUR BARLEY, 46%, £4.25

A big, exciting step for the young Lowlands-based Lochlea distillery. Barley is the first single malt to join the distillery's core range! Following the popularity of its Single Malt First Release, the Lochlea team set about creating this expression for all to enjoy. Matured in a combination of ex-bourbon and ex-Oloroso sherry casks, as well as shaved, toasted and re-charred barriques, the whisky was bottled up without any added colour, or chill filtration.

2007 13 YEAR OLD SINGLE MALTS OF SCOTLAND, *48%, £5.85* A 2007 Lowland single malt from a mystery distillery that was matured in a pair of ex-bourbon barrels and one ex-sherry butt for 13 years, before being bottled in 2021. Aromas of grapefruit, juicy raisins, grape-flavoured bubble gum and flinty river rock pools fill the nose, complemented by notes of grapefruit juice, flaky shortcrust pastry, burnt caramel, treacle cake and lemon.

# BLENDED

COMPASS BOX THE STORY OF THE SPANIARD, 43%, £4.85 This blended malt from the ever-inventive Compass Box if perfect for whisky fans who love a well-sherried dram. This expression is built around whisky drawn from sherry and Spanish red wine casks. 48% of the whisky was aged in ex-sherry casks, while a further 25% was aged in ex-Spanish red wine casks.

#### OLD PERTH ORIGINAL, 46%, £3.10

Old Perth The Original is a blended malt whisky from Perth, made exclusively with whisky matured in ex-sherry casks from a selection of Scotland's finest distilleries. A very well put together whisky, that achieves exactly what it sets out to: a great everyday sherried whisky to enjoy with friends.

# WHISKEY

COTSWOLDS RESERVE, 50%, England, £5.15

Very smooth and elegant Cotswolds Reserve Single Malt is hand crafted in small batches using 100% locally grown Cotswold barley. This expression showcases the influence of our first-fill ex-Bourbon barrels which provide typical notes of vanilla, honey, butterscotch and a hint of coconut, resulting in a truly well-balanced dram.

KAVALAN SELECT NO.2 BOTTLING NOTE, *40%, Taiwan, £6.15* An exciting addition to Kavalan's range, which is intended to showcase the Taiwanese distillery's skill in blending & cask selection. Distillery Select No.2 focuses on a floral, herbal flavour profile and is a fantastic exploration of the characteristics which masterful distillation, aging, and blending can achieve.

NIKKA COFFEY MALT BOTTLING NOTE, *45%, Japan, £5.25* While most distilleries use their Coffey stills only to make grain whisky, Nikka use the two Coffey stills at their Miyagikyo distillery to create malt whisky too. The expression was introduced to their selection of expressions in 2014. Plenty rich & flavoursome, it's a wonderful addition to Nikka's fantastic range.

#### GREEN SPOT, 40%, Ireland, £4.15

Green Spot is a fabulous single pot still whiskey and much loved by the critics. This Irish whiskey has come far from the days when it was only sold in Mitchell's grocer shop in the heart of Dublin, though its flavour profile is still just as robust. The whiskey has matured in a combination of first and second fill bourbon casks as well as sherry casks.

# BOURBON

FOUR ROSES SMALL BATCH, 45% £3.25 Small production of a really simple and juicy bourbon, from sipping till cocktails is an all-day drinking and mixing whiskey.

YELLOWSTONE SELECT KENTUCKY STRAIGHT, *46.5%, £4.35* Made by seventh-generation distillers Paul and Steve Beam, this is a blend of sweet, spicy and smoky bourbons. Yellowstone was launched in 2015 in homage to the Limestone Branch Distillery founders' great-grandfather, Minor Case Beam, who sold his distillery to Yellowstone over a century before.

# GRAPPA, LIMONCELLO AND MARSALA

GRAPPA DI BARBERA DISTILLERIA, Italy £7.50

This grappa from Montanaro is made with Nebbiolo grapes harvested from Barbaresco, Piedmont, in Italy. A vegetal note on the nose followed by fresh, crisp, juicy grapes, floral blossom with a peppery, dry finish.

#### GRAPPA DI BAROLO 9 ANNI MAROLO, *Italy £7.75* Established in Alba in 1977, Marolo produces premium grappas based on the

pomace of noble grape varieties from local vineyards. This particular release is made from Nebbiolo grapes, the very same variety used in Barolo wines. The liquid was matured in small oak barrels for 9 years and the result is a complex grappa, featuring floral and fruity notes, with hints of cinnamon, vanilla and liquorice.

#### STAIBANO LIMONCELLO D'AMALFI IGP, Italy, £5.25

Staibano, The Original Limoncello, is made fresh on the Amalfi Coast. This premium limoncello is 100% natural and bears the Amalfi Lemon IGP stamp, guaranteeing it is made using only the finest Amalfi lemons IGP. A creation of Don Vincenzo Staibano dating back to the 1930s, Staibano Limoncello is now made by the Don's great-grandson. This fresh, light and zesty limoncello is perfect as an after dinner shot.

#### LIMONCINO DI MURAVERA, Italy, £4.75

Limoncino is Bresca Dorada's Sardinian answer to Limoncello. After the first swirl, with sometime in the glass, this Old World wine reveals wonderfully expressive aromas of pink grapefruit, lime, kumquat and grapefruit, rounded off by other fruity nuances. On the tongue, this powerful wine is characterized by an incredibly creamy texture. In the finish, this wine from the wine-growing region of Sardinia finally inspires with a beautiful length.

CURATOLO ARINI MARSALA SUPERIORE DOLCE NV, *Italy, £3.25* Dark amber in colour, with aromas of dried figs, sultanas and caramel. This wine is round and soft on the palate with fresh notes of dried fruit, nuts and honeysuckle with a pleasant, sweet and clean finish.
