WHITE WINE

▼ Grillo, Serenata Bio Sicilia Organic DOC, Italy (Sicily)

Distinct and characterful on the nose, with a floral bouquet. The palate has hints of citrus and tropical fruits and is mouth-filling.

▼ Sea Change Pinot Grigio, Italy (Veneto)

Balanced, fresh and crisp, with aromas of freshly cut pears, kiwifruit and musk, with hints of citrus flowers and nougat.

▼ Janelas Antigas, Vinho Verde, Portugal (Vinho Verde)

An exciting and refreshing wine that perfectly combines the aromas of four of the most famous grape varieties of the region resulting in a very fresh and fruity wine, with a balanced acidity.

The Guv'nor Blanco, Spain (Castilla)

Juicy notes of ripe citrus and tropical fruits, rich satisfying white, like The Guv'nor, knows how to deliver.

▼ Pecorino, Bio Dega Vigna Madre Organic, Italy (Abruzzo)

Floral notes of broom and hawthorn, and then continues with scents of lemon zest, pear and apple, then it ends with scents of freshly cut grass. Fresh and savoury with a slight buttery note.

Picpoul de Pinet Villa Blanche, France (Languedoc)

Gleaming and bright, with a subtle nose of citrus and white flowers, elderberry and aniseed underscored by a fresh salinity.

Sauvignon Blanc, Akarana, New Zealand (Waipara)

Vibrant and bursting with zesty citrus fruit flavours.

Entreflores Albariño, Spain (Rias Baixas)

Elegant, very rich palate, fleshy and well structured. Fresh and acidic mid-palate highlights subtle varietal character, enhanced by some fruity notes.

ROSÉ

▼ Entreflores Rosé, Spain (Navarra)

Intensely fresh to the nose, with noticeable aromas of strawberry and flowers. Well balanced and tasty in the mouth.

▼ Sea Change Pinot Grigio Rosé, Italy (Veneto)

The nose is packed with notes of wild strawberry, cranberry and a hint of juniper. Fresh and crisp, light and easy to drink.

L'Oasis Provence Rosé, France (Provence)

An elegant, floral bouquet prepares you for the ample, fruity flavours.



RED WINE

▼ Nero d'Avola, Serenata Bio Sicilia Organic DOC, Italy (Sicily)

A characterful fruit-driven red, which is soft, approachable and easy to drink. Intense and wellbalanced, packed with red berry fruit flavours.

▼ Merlot, Daguët de Berticot, France (Cotes de Duras)

The wine has a ruby red colour. The nose reveals notes of red fruits and spice. The palate is full of smooth tannins.

▼ Recantos de Lisboa Reserva Tinto, Portugal (Lisbon)

This Reserva red wine has a wonderful nose, harmoniously blended on the palate. Intense red fruits are accompanied by delicate spice aromas. It is soft but full-bodied, with a persistent finish.

▼ Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Bio Dega Vigna Madre Organic, Italy (Abruzzo)

The hints of red fruits such as cherry, blueberry, black currant and blackberry and plum blend with the floral notes of rose and violet with a slight spicy note. Dry and refreshing with soft tannins.

Picpoul Noir Villa Blanche, France (Languedoc)

Fresh with red cherry in all its forms, and floral notes such as broom flowers. Followed by spicy notes of peppermint and star anise. Fine tannins, delicious pomegranate and redcurrant. This is a wine that we prefer served simply, lightly chilled.

▼ Malbec, Bodega Piedra Negra Organic, Argentina (Mendoza)

On the nose red summer fruit aromas dominate with a slight touch of black pepper. On the palate there is an attractive concentration of ripe red fruits which gives volume to the wine.

▼ Entreflores Rioja Crianza D.O.C, Spain (Rioja)

Ripe red cherry, intense, very clean. Notes of black fruits, toast, cinnamon and toffee. Good structure, meaty and well balanced. Pair with grilled or stewed red meat, sausages and cheeses.

ORANGE & NATURAL WINES

▼ Orange Wine, Cramele Recas, Romania (Banat)

Dark straw colour with orange hints, the nose is a delicate melange of quince, Williams pear and a hint of vanilla. A complex and structured wine, with elegant but discreet fruit flavours of stone fruits, backed up with a powerful tannin structure and long finish. Natural wine lovers delight.

▼ Logan Clementine Pinot Gris Natural, Australia (NSW)

Bright and rich aromas of red apple, wild strawberry, florals (honeysuckle and rose) and spice (cinnamon, ginger and fennel seed) with stone fruit.

▼ Logan Clementine Blanc de la Mer, Australia (NSW)

Bright aroma of grapefruit, passionfruit, rose, poached quince and nashi pear with white peach, salty tang of sea spray on the palate.

SPARKLING WINE

▼ Sea Change Free 0% Sparkling Wine, Italy (Veneto)

Hints of elderflower, crisp apple and summer mint set the taste buds alive. Its elegant perlage make Sea Change Free a refreshing and enjoyable companion to any occasion (alcohol free).

Prosecco, Pirani D.O.C Extra Dry, Italy (Veneto)

A beautiful straw yellow with elegant perlage. Soft notes of apple. Very easy drinking. SWA Commended.

Prosecco Rosé, D.O.C Pirani Extra Dry, Italy (Veneto)

A lovely delicate rose colour. Fresh fruity palate showing red summer fruits, flowers and violets. Great on its own or with fish dishes as well as white meat and vegetable dishes.

▼ Ridgeview Bloomsbury, England (Sussex)

Ditchling Common, Sussex. Fresh, but complex with citrus, peach and brioche delivering a fine, persistent mousse.

▼ Ridgeview Fitzrovia Rose, England (Sussex)

An elegant sparkling rose, using a portion of carefully handcrafted red wine from ripe Pinots and adding it to a Chardonnay dominant white base wine.

Rathfinny Classic Cuvee 2018, England (Sussex)

Vivid aromas of grapefruit, red apple and brioche on the nose. The palate has a real focus with zesty acidity tempered by a creamy texture and rich, biscuity notes, leading to a refreshing and moreish finish.

DESSERT WINES

Chateau Les Mingets Sauternes, France (Sauternes)

A rich and concentrate dessert wine that has luscious character, intense flavours of caramelised fruits, pear, melon and almond. Rounded and balanced by a good acidity on the finish.
